READING

This half term we will read

- A Midsummer Nights Dream by Andrew Mathews and Tony Ross.
- I Am Not a Label by Cerrie Burnell
- Boy in the Tower by Polly Ho-Yen.

We will focus on predicting, personal responses to texts, understanding themes, summarising paragraphs, explain how a piece of evidence supports a point and using inference to support summarising a paragraph.

WRITING

Balanced Argument-

 - Views need to be supported with evidence to convince

Third Person Stories Set in Another Culture-Pupils will know:

- Dialogue can help tell the story and convey information about characters
- An expanded noun phrase is a simple noun phrase expanded with at least one adjective.

MATHS

This half term we will be learning about:

- Place value and negative numbers.
- Addition and subtraction.
- Multiplication.
- Measures (length, mass and capacity)

HISTORY

This term we are studying Ancient Greece including Greek life and their influence on the Western World. Our key questions are:

- Who were the Ancient Greeks and when did they rule?
- What beliefs did the Ancient Greeks hold?
- City States-What was the difference between Athens and Sparta?
- What was democracy like in Athens?
- Why was the theatre important to Ancient Greeks?
- Why were the Olympic Games invented by the Ancient Greeks?

SCIENCE

This half term's unit is a physics unit in which the children will focus on forces The key questions we will focus on are:

- When is friction helpful and when is it not?
- What's the affect of air resistance?
- What's the effect of water resistance?

GEOGRAPHY

This term we are studying 4 and 6 figure grid reference. We will be exploring the following key questions:

- What are 4 and 6 figure grid references and how do we use them?
- How can I precisely describe locations, landmarks and places as geographers?

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This half term we will focus on why Christians think Jesus is a great teacher.

We will think about the answers to the following key questions:

- Why did Jesus tell this story?
