READING

This half term we will read

MATHS

This half term we will be learning about:

- Geometry: Angles and Measures
- Multiplication and division.
- Fractions
- Multiplication and Area

HISTORY

This term we are studying Ancient Greece including Greek life and their influence on the Western World. Our key questions are:

- Who were the Ancient Greeks and when did they rule?
- What beliefs did the Ancient Greeks hold?
- City States-What was the difference between Athens and Sparta?
- What was democracy like in Athens?
- Why was the theatre important to Ancient Greeks?
- Why were the Olympic Games invented by the Ancient Greeks?

SCIENCE

This half term's unit is a biology unit in which the children will focus on describing the changes as humans develop to old age. The key questions we will focus on are:

- What is the human timeline?
- How do we change into adults?
- How does human and gestation in animals and humans compare?

GEOGRAPHY

This term we are studying how to locate world countries, biomes and vegetation belts. We will be exploring the following key questions:

- Where would you find some of the major countries of the world?
- Where would you find some of the major cities in the world?
- What is a biome?
- How do Biomes change across the world?
- What are the physical characteristics that define Europe, North and South America?
