## READING

Our reading focus book for this half term are The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch by Ronda and David Armitage and The Storm Whale by Benji Davies. We will be discussing the sequence of events and work towards retelling the stories. We will be discussing parts of the texts and making inferences on the basis of what is being said and done.

## WRITING

In our writing lessons we will be focusing on the texts The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch and creating instructional writing. We will then focus on the book The Storm Whale with an outcome on retelling the story focusing on stories with familiar settings.

## MATHS

This half term we will be focusing on-

- Geometry (shape)
- Multiplication and Division
- Measurement
- Mental Addition and Subtraction
- Statistics and Calculation

## HISTORY

In history we are continuing our focus on lives of significant people.

The key questions we will focus on are:

- Who was Neil Armstrong? What did he achieve?
- Who is Mae Jemison? What did she achieve?
- Who is Bernard Harris Jr? What did he achieve?
- Who is Tim Peake? What did he achieve?

## SCIENCE

This half term we will be revisiting Plants and Animals including humans.

The key questions are?

- Can we remember it- Animals, including humans.
- Can we elaborate it- Animals, including humans.
- Can we remember it? What do we know about plants and seasons?

## GEOGRAPHY

We are going to be focusing on mapping and fieldwork. This half term the key questions are-

- What is a map?
- How do I make an imaginary map? We're Going on a Bear Hunt
- How do you show what a place is like? The Storm Whale
- How do I make a real map?

## SEAHORSE CLASS – SUMMER 2 OVERVIEW CYCLE A

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We will be focusing on what happened at the Ascension and Pentecost. The key questions are-

- Why is Ascension a special celebration in the church year?
- What happened at Pentecost?
- Why is Pentecost often called the Birthday of the Church?
- How does it feel when we say goodbye?

### PSHE

In PSHE we will be focusing on Health and wellbeing, growing and changing and keeping safe. Key questions-

- How do people grow from young to old?
- What are the body parts names?
- How do we keep safe in different environments?

### PHYSICAL EDUCATION

In PE we will be focusing on games- net and wall. We will be demonstrating how to catch a ball, to show a side gallop with some rhythm, show the ready position, demonstrate how to catch a ball, how to hold a bat, how to strike a ball and apply simple tactic in a net/wall game.

### ART

In Art this half term we will be focusing on 3D art. We will know that sculptors make their ideas come to life by joining or moulding materials together and that sculptors sometimes first make small-scale models of their work called maquettes. Can we-

- Join materials together to form a 3D work of art?
- Make a small rough draft of a sculpture to explore ideas?

### MUSIC

In music the musical spotlight is- Our Big Concert. This will be an opportunity to present songs to create a performance.

We will be thinking about-  
How does music teach us about looking after our planet?

### COMPUTING

We will be developing programming in computing.

- How can we create and debug simple programs?
- Can we use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programs?
- How to simplify a program by using a loop.
