GOSPEL VALUE FOCUS

Courage- We will be talking to our pupils about dealing with tricky times and how to have the courage to dig deep and solve problems that life throws at us.

BRITISH VALUE FOCUS

The fundamental British Values are: Democracy -This is about making decisions together and making sure that everyone has a voice and the right to express their opinion.

READING

We will be spending the first week of this half term looking at making a strong start to writing before beginning our reading unit. We will then be looking at the text Rooftoppers by Katherine Rundell, Pig Heart boy and How to Live forever. By the end of the unit your child will be able to understand organisational devices to navigate a text efficiently and by able to make inferences to draw overarching

WRITING

We will be spending two weeks on Autobiographies and your child will be able to sequence and describe events chronologically and factually. In their grammar they will be using relative clauses, relative pronouns, prepositions, conjunctions and adverbs, why not ask them what all of these are? We will then be moving on to writing speeches and poetry.

MATHS

In maths we will be starting with place value and looking at the importance of number. We will then be swiftly moving into our four operations as we begin to develop our skills in number and arithmetic skills. It is paramount that your child is confident with all of their times tables to ensure they can make accelerated progress.

HISTORY	SCIENCE
We are studying WW2 with a main focus on the local area and how Kirkham, Wesham, Preston and Lancashire were affected during the war. We will be working chronologically to ensure that have an accurate understand of when and where events happened. If you have any links to people who were in the war or any medal etc then please let us know.	In Science we are looking at Electricity. We are focusing most of our learning on different types of circuits and how electricity flows. We will be delving deep into trying to understand electrons and neutrons etc. We will also be learning more about conducting fair tests.

Use logical reasoning to explain how some simple algorithms work and to detect and correct errors in algorithms and programs.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY
