YEAR SIX- SUMMER 1 OVERVIEW

GOSPEL VALUE FOCUS

INDIVIDUAL LIBERTY

READING

In reading we will be developing our understanding by reading the following texts: Intro to Dickens- Oliver Twist and Dare to be You. Within Oliver Twist we will be laying the foundations for KS3 whilst focusing on language themes, styles and expected vocabulary within the genre. In Dare to be you we will be using this as a transition text to prepare the pupils for high school. We will be extrapolating key themes and important messages conveyed in the text.

WRITING

We will be starting out new term with an Extended 3rd Person Narrative based around a previous discovered text. We will also be developing our grammar skills throughout this unit including mastering Year 6 punctuation. We will then be rediscovering discursive speeches.

MATHS

This half term we will be developing our understanding in reasoning. We will be preparing for the KS2 assessments. We will therefore be recapping previous content this term. We will then progress to problem solving and developing our mastery skills in maths.

HISTORY	SCIENCE
This term we will be looking at the 5 significant monarchs of England. This is to prepare us for our annual visit to London. We will be thinking about: How is William I remembered? What legacy did he leave? How is Henry VIII remembered? What legacy did he leave? How is Elizabeth I remembered? What legacy did she leave? How is Charles II remembered? What legacy did he leave? How is Queen Victoria remembered? What legacy did she leave? In your opinion, who was the greatest past monarch? Why is that?	This half term we will be looking at the unit of Living things and their habitats. We will be able to: describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals and be able to give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics

GEOGRAPHY

This half term we will be using OS maps and fieldwork. We will be using our new Orienteering map and course to develop our understanding of human and physical geography.

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RELIGIOUS EDUCATION
