GOSPEL VALUE FOCUS

HOPE- We will be thinking about what we are hopeful for and what we hope for in the future.

BRITISH VALUE FOCUS

The Rule of Law- We will be trying to understand the rules set in place for everyone and why they are important. It's also about following the rules to keep our society and our communities in order.

READING

In reading we will be developing our understanding by reading a range of texts. We will be looking at whole texts as well as short extracts to develop our reading fluency. Our class novel will be Holes by Louis Sacher- this is a great text about a boy who was in the wrong place at the wrong time, this links directly to our British Value Focus. We will then be using this text to develop our writing skills.

WRITING

In writing we will be looking at developing our sentence structure to create imagery in our writing. We will also be looking at the importance of balancing Description, Dialogue and Action to develop our narrative writing. We will also be writing a Diary extract in the style of a character, this will include understanding characterisation and varying our sentence length to create tension.

MATHS

This half term we will be developing our understanding in reasoning. We will be looking at shape, space and measure initially. This will include work around angles, properties of shapes and the knowledge around 2D and 3D structures. We will then progress to problem solving and developing our mastery skills in maths.
