Texts:

Leon and the Place Between

The Night before Christmas

Focus:

Finding evidence to support a given inference; reading with fluency.

WRITING

Through writing non-chronological reports and persuasive arguments, we will be strengthening our knowledge of sentence structure. There will be a big focus on handwriting and varying our sentence starters to enhance our writing.

MATHS

Adding and subtracting 2 and 3 digit numbers using the column method.

Using grid method for multiplication and division.

Telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

HISTORY

Looking at British history from the Bronze Age including religion, technology and trave. Researching the Iron Age, looking at hill forts: tribal kingdoms, farming, art and culture. Comparing the Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age. We will also be taking part in Stone Age workshop.

SCIENCE

Animal including Humans

Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat. Learn that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement

GEOGRAPHY

Geographical skills and fieldwork

Using maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.

Using the eight points of a compass (including the use of Ordnance Survey maps) to build knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world.

use fieldwork to observe, measure, record and present the human and physical features in the local area using a range of methods, including sketch maps, plans and graphs, and digital technologies

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RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

The big Questions this half term:

In what ways is God with us? How does it feel to be in the presence of God?

How did/does the presence of Jesus have an impact on people's lives? In what ways are we in the presence of Jesus in the world today?

PSHE

Safe Relationships

Personal boundaries; safely responding to others; the impact of hurtful behaviour, including online behaviour.

PHYSCIAL EDUCATION

This half term we will all be performing a dance. Children will be encouraged to work as a team, listen to each other's ideas and support and motivate each other to rehearse and refine their group dance. We hope to give parents the opportunity to some and see the dance be performed.

Art

This half term our focus in Design Technology.

MUSIC
